Itinerary

Day 1: Flight to Namibia

Day 2: Arrive in Windhoek, transfer to Guestfarm

Lodge in the country not far from the airport
Relaxing afternoon on this rustic farm. After p.m coffee and cake we depart on a nature drive on this 5000 hectare wildlife reserve ending with a sundowner under a setting African sun

Day 3: Drive to Lodge in the Khomas Hochland

Lodge at the foot of the Gamsberg
Afternoon game drive viewing a variety of animals. An interesting farm, endless valleys, setting sun over the Namib Desert, we enjoy great hospitality in this hidden away paradise

Day 4: Drive to Sesriem/Sossusvlei

Lodge near Sesriem
Drive via Solitaire to the unique dune sea of the mighty Namib Desert . At Solitaire we can stop for the world famous apple cake baked here. We continue along the majestic Naukluft Mountains to our lodge near Sesriem. Visit to Sesriem Canyon

Day 5: Sossusvlei

Lodge in the Namib Desert
We depart as early as possible on a drive into this great sand sea. We continue to the famous Dead and Sossus Vleis to walk among the dunes and photograph this beautiful landscape. We may decide to climb one of the highest dunes in the world

Day 6: Via the Ghaub and Kuiseb Passes to Swakopmund

Overnight at a comfortable Hotel or guesthouse
Along the sand sea and over the gravel plains of the Namib, we continue to the cosy town of Swakopmund on the mighty Atlantic Ocean. We enjoy a fine seafood dinner overlooking the ocean

Day 7: Swakopmund

Overnight at a comfortable Hotel or Guesthouse
We are booked on an interesting boat cruise on the Walvis Bay. There are an interesting variety of sea animals and birds to be seen on this special adventure trip. A number of surprises await us.

Day 8: Drive to the Erongo Mountains

Lodge amongst the massive granite boulders of the Erongo
A lovely area to walk, we may choose to do both a morning and a sunset guided walk. The local guides will share their in-depth knowledge of the African bush with us

Day 9: Drive to the Etosha National Park

Okaukuejo Restcamp at the waterhole
We arrive at Etosha, a park over 24000 sq km in size and teeming with wildlife, including elephant, rhino and lion. We go on a number of game drives to visit the many waterholes, open plains and Mopane thickets hoping to make a rare and special sighting

Day 10: Etosha National Park

Restcamp at Halali
We continue on our game drives on the many small roads in this park. A visit to the Pans edge and the waterholes Salvatore, Rietfontein and Nebrowni are a must. On the early morning game drive we have the biggest chance of finding those elusive Etosha lions and leopards

Day 11: Drive to Eastern Etosha

Lodge near Namutoni, eastern Etosha
Another day of wildlife viewing. We visit the vast Andoni Plains and the Fishers Pan, a haven for the many water birds found inland. We lunch at the historically interesting Namutoni Fort and depart for our special lodge late in the afternoon

Day 12: Travel to Rundu on the border with Angola

Lodge on the Okavango River
You enter "true Africa" travelling through an area with many traditional African kraals. The lodge is directly on the river where you will take a special sundowner boat cruise late in the afternoon.

Day 13: Drive through the Kavango Region

Lodge near the Mahango National Park
The lodge is directly on the Okavango River where the hippos often come out at night to graze between the bungalows. You will take your own game drive in the wildlife paradise that is Mahango National Park .

Day 14: Drive through Western Caprivi

Lodge directly on the Kwando River
Pure African Elephants, hippo, crocodile and many other animals in this sub-tropical wildlife rich area. Sundowner boat trip along meandering river channels, in-between riverine rich vegetation, in search of wild animals.

Day 15: Mazambala Island

Lodge on the Kwando River
Interesting game drive in Bwabwata National Park. At certain times of the year there are hundreds of elephant migrating through this area, an awesome sight to see when they go down to drink at the famous horseshoe bend.

Day 16+17: Transfer to Kasane /Botswana

Ichobezi Houseboat
We say goodbye to our guide and Tutwa Travel transfer us to Kasane in Botswana to our luxury houseboat. We embark on the ultimate cruise on the Chobe where we spend 2 nights within the borders of one of the most famous parks in Africa. We have an awesome view of the surrounding wetlands and river bank of the park where at times hundreds of elephant and other animals congregate. We take game boat trips within meters of the wild animals, birding trips and the fishing is also fantastic.

Day 18: Transfer to Victoria Falls

Lodge on the Zambezi River, BB
The lodge overlooks the deep gorges of the Zambezi, down river from the mighty Victoria Falls. Transfer to the world famous Victoria Falls where the Zambezi River drops over 110 meters over a cliff 1700 meters wide, to the gorge below. Known as the Smoke that Thunders, the picture of these falls will remain etched in your memory forever.

Day 19: Flight Victoria Falls - Johannesburg

In the morning you may decide to go river rafting, on a boat cruise on the Zambezi River or possibly a scenic flight above the falls. Transfer to airport for afternoon flight. Return to Europe on night flight out of Johannesburg.

Day 20: Return home
