Option 1: Namibia Classic Tour



Itinerary

1. Day: International Flight

2. Day: Arrive Windhoek

Lodge near Windhoek, DBB
Relax at the swimmingpool. After coffee & cake, depart on a game drive ending with a sundowner.

3. Day: Journey through Khomas Hochland

Lodge at the Gamsberg pass, DBB
Sundowner drive on the farm.

4. Day: Depart to Sesriem/Sossusvlei

Lodge near the gateway to Sossusvlei, DBB
The journey takes you down the escarpment to the edge of the great sand sea. Continue via Solitaire to your lodge at Sesriem. After walking the geologically interesting Sesriem canyon you can continue to the Elim Dune for a walk up to the summit for a sundowner.

5. Day: Sossusvlei

Lodge in the Namibdesert, BB
You depart at sunrise along the Tsauchab River deep into the dune sea all the way to Sossusvlei and Dead Vlei. After walking this wonderful area for a few hours you can enjoy a well deserved picnic under the huge Camelthorn trees found here.

6. Day: Via the Gaub pass/Kuiseb pass to Swakopmund

Lodge at the beach, BB
You continue northwards on a scenic drive between the escarpment and the red sand dunes via the Gaub and Kuiseb Canyons, over the desolate gravel plains, to book into your cosy lodge on the edge of the Atlantic Ocean.

7. Day: Swakopmund

Lodge at the coast, BB
Today you take part in an interesting Marine Cruise, seals, dolphins, pelicans and other sea birds and marine life. Other activities of interest: Quadbiking in the dunes, a Living Desert Tour into the dunes, the aquarium, museum, crystall gallery, snake park and many interesting shops in this charming old colonial town.

8. Day: Journey to the Erongo mountains

Lodge in the Erongo mountains, between the bizarre rock formations, DBB
A beautiful granite boulder strewn environment. Guided walks at sunset and sunrise.

9. Day: Drive to the Etosha National Park

Okaukuejo Restcamp at the waterhole, BB
Etosha, The Great White Place, a park over 24000 sq km in size. Go on your own game drives to view the many animals and birds in this special and scenic park, including elephant, lion and rhinoceros. Relax and enjoy sightings of wild animals at night at the camps' waterhole.

10. Day: Etosha National Park

Halali Restcamp, BB
You continue on your own game drive all the way to Halali, visiting the many waterholes where the animals congregate, along the way. Halali is well known as a birding hotspot and the interesting Moringa waterhole set amongst the dolomite rocks.

11. Day: Drive to the eastern part of the park

Lodge near the eastern entrance to the park, DBB
Another day of game viewing in this animal kingdom. The old fort at Namutoni is worth a visit before you leave the park to reach your unique lodge nestled amongst the Terminalia trees with their bright red coloured winged fruits.

12. Day: Journey via Tsumeb/Otavi to the Waterberg

Waterberg Restcamp, BB
On the way to the Waterberg you may visit the bottomless lake Otjikoto. You continue via Grootfontein or Otavi to the sandstone cliffs of the Waterberg. The area is known for its variety of interesting trees and plants and many animal and bird species found there.

13. Day: Waterberg

Waterberg Restcamp, BB
There are a number of interesting walking trails that you may embark on to explore this scenic nature environment. You may also choose to take a game drive on the top of the plateau, home to a variety of big game including rhino, buffalo and giraffe.

14. Day: Drive to Windhoek

Overnight at the highest lying lodge in Namibia, DBB
End the tour on a high note in the Khomas Hochland overlooking the valleys below. You are booked on the Big Cats Tour which includes viewing of Leopard, Lion and Cheetah.

15. Day: International Flight

Departure flight from Windhoek.

16. Day: Back home

Arrive in your home country.
