## Itinerary

### 1. Day: International Flight

### 2. Day: Arrive Windhoek

Lodge near Windhoek, DBB  
Relax at the swimmingpool. After coffee & cake, depart on a game drive ending with a sundowner.

### 3. Day: Depart to Omaruru

Lodge in the Erongo mountains with bizarre rock formations, DBB  
Drive via Okahandja and a visit to the woodcarvers' market. A guided walk to learn about the fascinating flora and fauna at the Erongo is included.

### 4. Day: Drive via the Brandberg to Twyfelfontein

Lodge nestled among the ancient petrified dunes of Damaraland, DBB  
Sightseeing of the famous Bushman engravings, a World Heritage Site. A geologically fascinating area that includes the stone Organ pipes and Burnt Mountain.

### 5. Day: Via Palmwag towards Kaokoland

Lodge at Sesfontein, DBB  
Option to stop at Palmwag Lodge for a lunchbreak. With luck you may encounter the rare desert-adapted elephants. Succulents, trees and volcanic remains scatter this landscape. Fort Sesfontein, the gateway to Kaokoland was built as a fort by the Germans to defend themselves against the hostile natives. Kaokoland is home to the nomadic Himba tribe, a tribe that has kept the same traditions, dress and way of life for the past 500 years.

### 6. Day: Depart to the Kunene River on the Border to Angola

Lodge at the Epupa waterfalls, DBB  
Drive via the vibrant and colourful african town of Opuwo, the capital of the Kunene Region. Drive further past Himba Kraals to the Kunene River, which forms the border between Namibia and Angola. The thundering sound of the Epupa waterfalls is a welcome relief to the heat and dust of the Kaokoland.

### 7. Day: Epupa Falls

Lodge at the Epupa waterfalls, DBB  
Sightseeing of the waterfalls, hiking and perhaps cooling off in the Kunene River (Beware of Crocodiles!) We have the opportunity to visit a Himba settlement to find out more about this fascinating culture and to learn more about the daily lives of these people.

### 8. Day: Kunene River Lodge

Lodge at the Kunene River, DBB  
This is a birds paradise. Optional activities such as canoe and sundowner boat trips.

### 9. Day: Drive to Hobatere

Lodge on the wettern border of the Etosha National Park, DBB  
Gameviewing at the lodges' waterhole. We may see the desert elephants or possibly lions coming to quench their thirst. After dinner you take part in a night game Drive to find some of seldom seen night active animals.

### 10. Day: Journey to the Etosha National Park

Restcamp at Okaukuejo, BB  
Own game viewing drives in the park. Watching animals at the night lit waterhole at Okaukuejo.

### 11. Day: Etosha National Park

Restcamp at Okaukuejo, BB  
You will spend the day visiting many of the famous Etosha waterholes including Gembokvlakte, Olifantsbad, Salvadore and Rietfontein. The many antelope species are to be seen on vast open plains of the Etosha.

### 12. Day: Drive via Otjiwarongo to the Waterberg

Waterberg Restcamp, BB  
In the early morning we have yet another opportunity to sit at the waterhole and watch hundreds of wild animals coming and going. After a late breakfast we drive via Outjo and Otjiwarongo to our next destination, the Waterberg. This is a nature paradise, where almost all trees and shrubs in Namibia are found.

### 13. Day: Waterberg

Waterberg Restcamp, BB  
A lot of hiking possibilities and routes to choose from. Optional excursion to Okakarara, centre of the Herero people for an interesting cultural experience.

### 14. Day: Depart for Windhoek

Stay over at the highest lodge in Namibia, DBB  
Big Cats Tour: you will have a great experience with leopard, lion and cheetah

### 15. Day: International Flight

Return of rental vehicle and outbound flight.

### 16. Day: Back Home

Arrive in your home country
