### Daily itinerary

#### Day 1: Flight to Namibia

#### Day 2: Lodge outside Windhoek

Transfer to lodge near airport, afternoon game drive in bushveld savannah, DBB.

#### Day 3: Drive over the Khomas Hochland to the escarpment

Lodge on the Gamsberg Pass. Great service and good food. Farm drive in this special area overlooking the Namib Desert, DBB.

#### Day 4: Drive to Sesriem/Sossusvlei

Lodge at the entrance to the park. At Solitaire we may enjoy the legendary apple pie. Our lodge offers us sweeping views of the beautiful red sand dunes. Visit to Sesriem Canyon and/or Eilim Dune, DBB.

#### Day 5: Sossusvlei

Lodge in the Namib Desert, we enjoy a morning drive into the dune sea which includes a visit to Dead Vlei and Sossusvlei and the opportunity to walk up one of the highest dunes in the world, DBB.

#### Day 6: Via the Gaub and Kuiseb Canyons to Swakopmund

Lodge overlooking the Atlantic Ocean. Along the great sand sea, river canyons, gravel plains and Walvis Bay to Swakopmund. The small, friendly and historical town is fascinating with its many interesting buildings, shops and restaurants, DBB.

#### Day 7: Swakopmund

Lodge overlooking the Atlantic Ocean. Morning boat cruise in the protected and marine life rich Walvis Bay. A fresh contrast to the sandy desert we experience the dolphins, seals, flamingos, pelicans and many other sea animals and birds, DBB.

#### Day 8: Drive inland to the Erongo Mountains

Lodge in the Erongo Mountains nestled amongst the granite boulders. We take sunset and sunrise walks to learn more about the fascinating flora and fauna found here, DBB.

#### Day 9: Drive to the Etosha National Park

Restcamp at Okaukuejo Waterhole or private lodge outside park. A game reserve over 24000 sq km in size, we spend many hours going on our own adventurous game drives to view the huge variety of animals and birds, BB.

#### Day 10: Full day in the Etosha National Park

Overnight at one of the restcamps in the park. Continue on game drives via open grasslands, Mopane forests and waterholes to our next destination, DBB.

#### Day 11: Lodge in eastern Etosha

Lodge on private reserve on border of Etosha. Eastern Etosha with its unique Fishers Pan, offers us even more game viewing experiences. Accommodation, good service and African hospitality of a high standard await us, DBB.

### Please note:

You are welcome to make changes to the above program to create your very own unique tour. The program may change slightly depending on the lodges available at time of booking.

#### Day 12: Drive to Rundu on the Okavango River

Lodge on the Okavango River. The journey takes us on a drive past many traditional African villages. Sundowner boat cruise on the Okavango River, DBB.

#### Day 13: Travel to the Mahango National Park

Lodge on the Okavango at Divundu. View the Popa Falls. Visit nearby Mahango Park, home to a large variety of animals including hippo, buffalo, lion and many different antelope, DBB.

#### Day 14: Drive through western Caprivi

Lodge on the Kwando River. Afternoon relax and evening boat cruise on the Kwando River, a bird paradise, hippo and many water antelope, DBB.

#### Day 15: Mazambala Island

Lunch on the Kwando River. Game drive in the Bwabwata National Park, home to lion, leopard, elephant, hippo and many other interesting animals and birds. Riverine forest, hippo pools and the famous Horseshoe Bend, DBB.

#### Day 16: Transfer to Kasane, Chobe Park, Botswana

Overnight on deluxe houseboat, Chobe River. The houseboat is moored in the Chobe National Park and affords us direct access to an area that is home to 80 000 elephants, DBB.

#### Day 17: Chobe River, Botswana

Ichobezi Houseboat. Includes boat trips to fish or view a large variety of birds and animals including elephant, crocodile, buffalo, hippo and sometimes lions, DBB.

#### Day 18: Transfer to Victoria Falls

Lodge on the Zambezi River. Travel the short distance from Kasane to Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe. Our lodge is on the banks of the mighty Zambezi River with beautiful views, DBB.

#### Day 19: Victoria Falls

Lodge on the Zambezi River. Shuttle to the world famous Victoria Falls, the Smoke that Thunders, a sight so special, it will remain permanently etched in your memory. The falls are 1700 metres wide and have a fall of over 100 metres. Many other activities to choose from including river rafting, bungi jumping or helicopter flights, DBB.

#### Day 20: Flight from Victoria Falls to Johannesburg-Europe

Transfer to local airport for flight home
