Itinerary

Day 1: Flight to Namibia

Day 2: Arrive in Windhoek, transfer to Guestfarm

Lodge in the country not far from the airport
Relaxing afternoon on this rustic farm. After p.m coffee and cake we depart on a nature drive on this 5000 hectare wildlife reserve ending with a sundowner under a setting African sun

Day 3: Drive to the Kalahari semi-desert

Lodge in between the red sand dunes
Afternoon game drive in the Kalahari viewing a variety of animals. The many Camelthorn Trees are a dominant feature of this unique semi-desert paradise

Day 4: Drive via Keetmanshoop to the Fish River Canyon

Lodge at the Fish River Canyon. The unique southern Namib is home to a variety of interesting succulents and trees, including the Quiver Tree used by the local bushman to carry their bows and arrows

Day 5: Visit to the Fish River Canyon

Lodge at the Fish River Canyon, the second biggest Canyon in the world after the great Grand Canyon. A special area to take a walk and enjoy the magnificent views

Day 6: Drive along the Orange River bordering South Africa

Lodge in Aus. The Orange River flows through the beautiful Namaqualand area. This expansive untouched desert paradise is part of a new Transfrontier Park

Day 7: Drive to Luderitz

Hotel at the sea
We travel through the southern Namib to Luderitz. Our hotel is directly at the sea. The natural harbour was discovered in 1487 by the Portuguese explorer Bartholomew Diaz. We visit the ghost town of Kolmanskop which was built at the height of the diamond rush here over 100 years ago

Day 8: Drive to Namib Rand Nature Reserve

The exclusive Wolwedans Dune Camp, all inclusive
We continue from Aus along the vast dune sea along the Namib Rand Nature Reserve. This is one of the most scenic landscapes of Namibia. On our right the impressive Tiras Mountains part of the great escarpment, and to our left the red sand dunes of the Namib Desert stretching over one hundred kilometers to the coast

Day 9: Wolwedans Dune Camp

Wolwedans Dune Camp, all inclusive
We are taken on private drives into this huge and beautiful untouched nature paradise that is also extremely special to photograph. Apart from the enormous landscapes, there are a variety of wild animals to see including zebra, oryx, giraffe, springbok, ostrich and more

Day 10: Sesriem/Sossusvlei

Lodge near the park entrance
From our lodge we have views onto the huge dunes to the west and the Naukluft Mountains to the east. We visit the Sesriem Canyon, part of Tsauchab River that at times sends masses of water all the way to Sossusvlei, deep in the dunes. In the late afternoon we can walk up the Elim Dune for a sundowner and a view over the surrounding landscape, the sun setting over the vast sand fields

Day 11: Via the Ghaub Canyon to the Khomas Hochland

Guestfarm in the Khomas Hochland Mountains
We enjoy an early morning drive along the Tsauchab River deep into the dune sea to the famous Dead Vlei and Sossusvlei. We walk this special area and enjoy a sumptuous late breakfast under the huge camelthorn trees. We continue to Solitaire where we can enjoy the legendary apple cake made by baker „Moose“. We reach our special guestfarm near the Gamsberg Pass, in time for a sundowner game drive and a very special dinner

Day 12: Drive to the outskirts of Windhoek

Lodge overlooking the Khomas Hochland
We travel towards Windhoek to reach the highest lying lodge in Namibia. We are taken on an adventurous drive to experience the Big Cats, viewing lion, leopard and cheetah

Day 13: Flight departure Windhoek

We travel the short distance to Windhoek, the capital of Namibia, to return our vehicle and prepare for transfer to the airport. Windhoek is an interesting and cosmopolitan town. The many special shops, old colonial buildings and historic places of interest are worth a visit before our afternoon flight back home

Day 14: Arrival at home
